Daily Tasks

- Remove all rubbish and food packaging
- Shake out driver-side floor mat if sand visible
- Dry-wipe dashboard with microfiber cloth if dust layer present

Weekly Tasks

- Full vacuum of seats and carpets
- Wipe all hard surfaces with interior cleaner on microfiber cloth
- Remove and clean all floor mats
- Check AC vent surfaces for visible dust - brush and vacuum if needed
- Wipe interior glass if film or smearing visible

Monthly Tasks

- Full 10-step cleaning sequence (trash removal through final protection)
- Brush and vacuum all AC vents
- Condition leather seats or spot-clean fabric seats
- Vacuum and wipe boot and cargo area
- Full interior glass clean with ammonia-free cleaner
- Apply interior protectant to dashboard and door panels

Quarterly Tasks

- Deep clean all interior surfaces
- Slide seats and vacuum full length of seat rails

- Clean under front seats with flat nozzle attachment
- Apply two-coat leather conditioning treatment
- Inspect and replace worn or damaged floor mats
- Check spare wheel compartment for moisture and debris
- Clean child seat anchor points (ISOFIX recesses) if applicable

Sandstorm Recovery Checklist

- Check all interior surfaces for fine dust deposit
- Vacuum seats and carpet before wiping any surface
- Use crevice tool on seat rails and door pocket bases
- Wipe dashboard, console, and door panels with interior cleaner
- Brush and vacuum all AC vents
- Clean floor mats separately outside the vehicle
- Inspect cabin air filter - replace if heavily loaded

Most Forgotten Areas - Check Every Month

- Seat rails (slide seats fully forward and back)
- Under front seats - use flat nozzle attachment
- Door pocket bases
- Cup holder recesses - use detailing brush
- Boot corners and spare wheel compartment
- Child seat anchor points (ISOFIX recesses)
